





# Venture Car Update



88 new Venture passenger rail cars purchased in partnership with Illinois, Wisconsin and Missouri for Midwest Amtrak routes.

54 Coach, 17 Business Class, 17 Café



Currently 80 in revenue service, including 9 café cars



All coach and business cars in service, with all Café cars expected to be in service in 2025.


## MIPRC Update

- Received \$1.84M CRISI grant for "Invest Midwest" to advance planning work that will build on FRA's Midwest Regional Rail Plan.
- MIPRC-Amtrak are planning to submit a joint application under the current Federal State Partnership NOFO to help offset Midwest locomotive overhaul costs

### Service Development Planning

- FRA Corridor ID
  - Detroit/Pontiac-Chicago with extension to Canada
  - Port Huron-Chicago
  - Grand Rapids-Chicago
  - Detroit-Toledo-Cleveland (led by Ohio Rail Development Commission)
- Holland-Grand Rapids-Lansing-Detroit
- Consultant teams selected for all routes
- Multi-year process to complete Steps 1 & 2

#### 2019 SOGR Grant Funding

- \$6.5 M SOGR grant funding to match \$6.5 M in State funding and Amtrak funds
- Work includes:
  - Track and signal infrastructure reliability improvement projects over the entire corridor
  - Install 23 back up generators
  - Replace 17 switch heaters and bring in natural gas
  - Replace 26 gate mechanisms
  - Replace 10 turn outs



#### 2020 CRISI Grant Funding

- \$23.4 M CRISI grant funding to match
   \$14.6 M in State funding and \$1.0 M from Amtrak
- Work includes:
  - Trespass prevention and pedestrian safety enhancements between Kalamazoo and Dearborn
  - Enhancement includes adding fencing and improving select grade crossings
  - Addressing high pedestrian incident locations in Kalamazoo, Albion, Ann Arbor, Ypsilanti, and Ypsilanti Township

#### 2020 SOGR Grant Funding

- \$15.6M SOGR grant funding to match \$12.5 M in State funding and \$3.0 M in Amtrak funds
- Work includes:
  - Modifications to 42 curves (6 to 8 curves in 2023)
  - Improving 16 public and 8 private at-grade crossings
  - Replacing 80,000 feet of existing curve worn rail and lighter rail sections
- 30 Curves completed to date
- completion in 2025



#### 2021 SOGR Grant Funding

\$1.5M to fund PE/NEPA for proposed reconstruction on five deficient bridges on MDOT's accelerated rail corridor


#### FY23/FY24 CRISI Announcement

- Amtrak was awarded \$8.4M for final design to restore double track on Amtrak's ownership approximately between Niles and Dowagiac
  - 20% match from Amtrak and MDOT
- MDOT was awarded \$67.4 million for upgrades to the Livernois Yard freight intermodal yard in Detroit. Project will be implemented in partnership with Norfolk Southern and City of Detroit and will lead to improved freight rail operations in SE Michigan.

#### Pending MDOT Grant Applications: FSP

Final design and construction on four of the bridges that we previously received 2021 SOGR to complete PE/NEPA

Replacement of track ties, crossing signals, turnouts, and rail resurfacing to maintain the 110 MPH accelerated speeds on State-owned Kalamazoo to Dearborn segment
